Recommendations for Future Events:

1. Class Timing Clarification

2. Contestant Cap or Time Extension

Due to the increasing number of participants, I suggest that DMA consider **limiting the number of contestants per discipline** or **extending the allotted time** for each discipline to ensure all dancers receive fair and sufficient time for evaluation.

3. Revision of Acro Scholarship

It is recommended that the **Acro Scholarship format be reviewed**, particularly for **Phases 3 and 4**, by implementing **time limits** to ensure consistency and maintain the schedule.
