



## SOLO TITLE GUIDE

### ATTIRE FOR EVENTS

- **ORIENTATION MEETING:** Crown, sash, and/or medallion, with dressy daytime casual clothes, over your dance attire.
- **TITLE COMPETITION CLASSES:**
  - **Female Contestants:**
    - *Ballet Audition* - One-piece black leotard. No embellishments, logos and no undergarments showing. Pink tights (footed or convertible)
    - *Tap, Jazz, Modern, Acrobatics Audition* - One-piece black leotard. No embellishments, logos and no undergarments showing. Pink or skin-tone tights (footed, stirrup, footless, or convertible)
      - **NEW THIS YEAR...sheer and lace allowed on audition leotard!**
  - **Male Contestants:**
    - Black form fitting pants (ankle, below or above the knee length), or black tights. Dance belt. Black form fitting compression shirt or muscle shirt tucked in.
- **INTERVIEWS:**
  - **Female Contestants** - Dressy daytime or business attire
  - **Male Contestants** - Dress shirt and tie, socks, and either dress pants or a suit
- **WELCOME PARTY:**
  - **Female Contestants** - Dressy daytime or business attire
  - **Male Contestants** - Dress shirt and tie with either dress pants or a suit
- **OPENING NUMBER:**
  - **Female Contestants** – One-piece leotard in color shown below. No embellishments, logos, and no undergarments showing. Skin tone tights. Skin tone jazz shoe. *If you are in doubt of the color, contact your Title Director.*
    - **Miss** – Royal Blue / **Teen** – True Red / **Junior** – Dark Purple / **Petite** – Canary Yellow
  - **Male Entrants** – Black form fitting pants, ankle or capri length. Black form fitting compressions shirt or muscle shirt. Black jazz shoes.
- **AWARDS PRESENTATION**
  - **Female Contestants** - Dressy daytime or business attire
  - **Male Contestants** - Dress shirt and tie with either dress pants or a suit

NOTE: You may choose to wear a different outfit of the same style that you are wearing for the Welcome Party Parade, Interview, and Awards Presentation.

### JUDGES PREVIEW

All contestants are required to submit a video of their routine, in costume and full make-up, via Dropbox (title director will send the information) by June 1<sup>st</sup>.

## **PERSONAL FACT SHEET**

All entrants must submit a typed, one-page, fact sheet via JotForm in a word document. Please **DO NOT make reference to your teacher of record, teachers of recognition, choreographers, or the name of your studio.** Your fact sheet should include interesting facts about yourself, in bullet form, that you would like the judges to know. Teachers, parents, and Chapter Secretaries are responsible for proofreading the fact sheet prior to submission. An example of the required format can be found below.

## **ENTRY FEES**

- Miss and Mr. Dance of America - \$495.00

- Petite Miss and Master Dance of America - \$375.00

All Affiliated Chapter Title Holders' Entry Fees include entry into the competition, program book picture, a scholarship to the National Convention (excluding food functions), three (3) free tickets to their Solo Title Scholarship Competition, one (1) Solo Program of their competition and one (1) free ticket to each of the other Solo Title Scholarship Competitions.

The Medical Information Form can be found in your Solo Title Competition Information Packet and **MUST** be turned in at the Solo Title Orientation Meeting.

## **TITLE JOTFORM ENTRY:**

- Headshot
- Dance Pose
- Music
